

**Grassroots Arts Program**

**Schedule of County Allotments for Fiscal Year 2009-2010 with Adjusted Allotments and Multicultural Amounts**

This schedule is based on an adjusted statewide Grassroots allocation of \$2,710,245 less a five percent budget reduction or \$2,574,733 according to the following formula:

\* 20% in equal grants/\$5,149 x 100 = \$514,947

\* 80% by population base / \$2,059,786

The allotments are based on a state population of 9,397,397 as determined by the 2009 population projection by the State Data Center. These figures are rounded. Counties with Designated County Partners are shown in bold.
