

**Grassroots Arts Program
Tentative Schedule of County Allotments for Fiscal Year 2009-2010**

This schedule is based on a tentative Grassroots Arts Program budget of \$2,710,245, which is the recurring 2008-09 Grassroots allocation amount. We emphasize that the amounts shown on this chart are **tentative** and will most likely change. Please use these figures to complete your 2009-10 Grassroots Arts Program application. The allocation formula is as follows:

* 20% in equal grants/\$5,420 x 100 = \$542,049

* 80% by population base / \$2,168,196

The allotments are based on a state population of 9,397,397 as determined by the 2009 population projection prepared by the State Data Center. These percentages and amounts are rounded figures. Counties with Designated County Partners are shown in bold.
