

**Grassroots Arts Program
Schedule of County Allotments for Fiscal Year 2010-2011**

This schedule is based on a statewide Grassroots allocation of \$2,642,320 according to the following formula:

* 20% in equal grants/\$5,284 x 100 = \$528,464

* 80% by population base / \$2,113,856
