This schedule is based on a statewide Grassroots allocation of \$2,303,708 according to the following formula:

* 20 percent in equal grants: $\$4,607 \times 100 = \$460,742$

* 80 percent by population base: $\$1,842,966$

The allotments are based on a state population of 9,828,598 as determined by the 2012 population projection by the State Data Center. These figures are rounded to the nearest dollar. Counties with Designated County Partners are shown in bold.
