

# Tissue Quilt Workshop - Technical Rider

Maya Freelon's Tissue Quilt Workshop: **Resilience**

## **The following is needed for each workshop -**

- Large art room, multipurpose space, gym, or auditorium stage that can accommodate at least five, 6-8 foot tables, or at least five 72" round tables.
- Table cloth, drop cloth, or recycled paper to protect the tables.
- At least 5 tables and chairs (5-10 participants at each table, max 50 participants)
- 1 parent or teacher volunteer per table
- Projector and screen with Mac/Apple compatibility
- High Speed internet
- Two strong anchor points at least 10' high and 30' across, to hang cloth clothesline (tension weight less than 10lbs)

## **The following is needed for workshops with over 25 participants -**

- Sound system/ PA, mic and amplification
- Live video stream or projecting capabilities

## **Additional resources which can help make it a memorable experience -**

- Invite parent volunteers, per 5 participants
- Invite Principal, head teacher, school officer, counselor, cafeteria personnel, gym teacher, maintenance person, or some other non-art related school employee to participate in the workshop (at least at the beginning).
- Dedicated camera, or computer to capture a time lapse video (could be cell phone)
- Student documentation: photography class, yearbook club, school newspaper...ect.
